Status

The department of Radiation-Oncology currently consists of 3 associates under independent status. We are also a training centre, so there is room for a fellow in training.

The department carries out its clinical activities at the St-Elisabeth campus in Uccle. The department also provides consultations at the St-Michiels campus in Etterbeek and at Halle General Hospital.

The department currently has 1 PET-CT simulator and 2 linear accelerators (1 completely new Elekta Harmony Linac (put into use on 1st June 2022) and 1 Siemens Artiste device which will soon be replaced by an Elekta VERSA HD Linac), equipment for surface scanning and IGRT, HDR brachytherapy and LDR brachytherapy. Contouring and planning is mainly done via Raystation.
